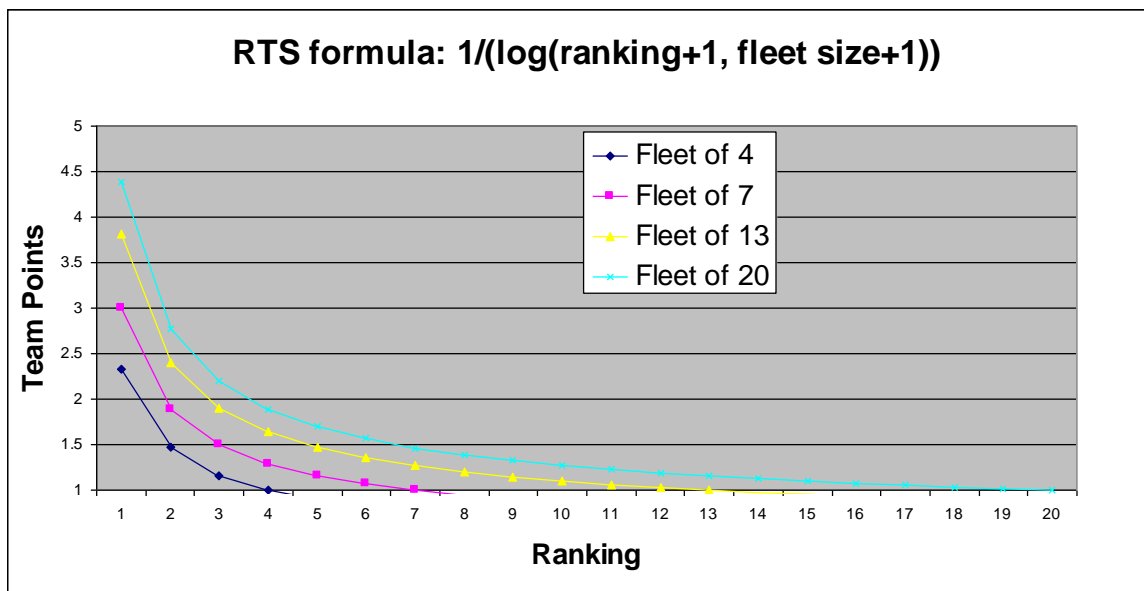


## “Live on the Edge” Team Cup Rules

1. A club team consists of four regatta entries that represent an established Yacht/Sailing Club or Fleet participating in the “Live on the Edge” Multihull Regatta. At least 3 of the entries need to be members of this club/fleet. An entry is considered a club/fleet member if the skipper is a club/fleet member.
2. A team can be declared until closing of the registration. There is no additional fee for a team entry.
3. Racing as a team member does not affect the individual race results.
4. Team members can sail in the same fleet or in different fleets.
5. There is no additional fee to enter a Club/Fleet Team. Individual Team member’s registration is sufficient.
6. Racing Rules of Sailing - appendix D (Team Racing Rules) does not apply.
7. Scoring is based on individual’s ranking in his/her fleet, at the completion of the Regatta. The RTS formula used for calculating team points for each team member accounts for the fleet size in which the team member races and is based on a logarithmic scale.

8. The team with highest total points will win the “Live on the Edge” Team Cup. This is a perpetual trophy. The winning team will receive one free regatta entry for the following year’s “Live on the Edge” Regatta to defend the Team Cup.
