

## Eugene Yacht Club Sail School June 19-24, 2011

*Welcome to Sail School. Here's How it All Works!*

- Sail School registration is open to **EYC Members\*** and a limited number of **Guests\***
- Registration includes class instruction, all meals, T-shirt, and other special prizes.
- All students (18 & under) must have a "supervising adult" on site. We encourage students to camp on the grounds, so bring necessary camping gear. (Supervising adult must be on site at night if student is camping.)
- There are plenty of tent sites and a limited number of RV spots available on the grounds.
- There are a *limited* number of non-student meal packages available (see below).
- Students are expected to help with KP duty and to follow all EYC club rules.
- Supervising adults are strongly encouraged to volunteer. We can use your help!
- Cost for Sail School is \$150 for **Members** and \$300 for **Guests**.
- You must use *one form for each* student (one tuition check is fine)
- Register early. The **deadline** for **Member** registration to guarantee a spot is May 20. After May 20 slots will be allotted to **Guests** on a 1<sup>st</sup> come, 1<sup>st</sup> serve basis.

## 2011 Sail School Classes

( A more complete class description is on the web under sail school information.)

**Zuma** (Beginning Sailing designed for 10-12 year olds) Students move from beginner to solo sailing.

**Laser I** – Beginning Lasers (*see note below*) This class focuses on learning to rig and sail a Laser sailboat.

**Laser II** – Intermediate Lasers (*see note below*) This class builds on Laser skills and improves confidence.

**Laser III** – Advanced Lasers (*see note below*) This class focuses on racing tactics and skills for Lasers

**Centerboard** (Beginning sailors) This is an entry level class for adults and older youth that focuses on learning to sail a sloop (2 sails).

**Catamarans** Learning to rig and sail a catamaran. Open to older youth and adults.

**Santana 20** (Introduction to Santana) This class is an intermediate class open to students that have sailing experience.

**Big Boats** (Cruising on larger boats) Learn to launch, retrieve, anchor and maintain larger boats.

### Note:

**All students in Laser classes** are required to provide their own boat. Please consult the EYC Website for suggestions to obtain a Laser for Sail School. In addition, all students in Laser I are required to demonstrate that their boat is “sail ready” between 3 and 5 pm on Sunday evening. Be there!

Make sure your boat is up to date on its registration – start early – ! (We learned the hard way).

Please do not contact Cynthia and Phil looking for a boat – we do not have access to extra boats or any brilliant ideas!

## WHAT TO BRING TO SAIL SCHOOL

### REQUIRED ITEMS:

Every student is required to wear at all times on the water a Coast Guard approved life jacket with a plastic waterproof whistle.

### RECOMMENDED ITEMS:

Hat, sun screen, sunglasses, insect repellent, bathing suit, several changes of clothing (layers work best), light jacket, boat shoes or aqua sox. (No black soled shoes on the boats!)
