Rules:

The regatta will be governed by the “rules” as defined in the racing rules of sailing 2009-2012 racing rules (RRS) governing each one design class participating, Except as modified in the sailing instructions (SI) or Appendices to the sailing instructions.

Boats & measurements:

All boats shall conform to each class's own rules and measurements. Each class shall administer its own compliance with these rules.

Event Schedule:

Saturday July 23

Late registration in EYC clubhouse until 11:00 am

Skipper Meeting EYC clubhouse 12:05 pm

Warning signal first race 1 pm (up to 5 races)

Dinner after last race of the day

Sunday July 24

Warning signal first race 10:30 am.

Last race warning no later than 2 pm.

Trophy presentation following subject to protests and calculations.

The race committee may adjust the racing schedule and area and marks used to suit the weather conditions.

Racing:

The sailing area for the EODI will be on Fern Ridge Reservoir, Eugene Oregon. Further details will be available in the sailing instructions at the skippers meeting.

Scoring:

The low point scoring system of the RRS appendix A will apply, as modified by each class rules and this notice of race. There will be no throw-outs

Trophies will be awarded to the top three in each class; except if the class has 25 or more participants' trophies will be awarded to the top five in that class.

Responsibility:

The organizing committee or EYC does not assume any responsibility of any sort regarding the participants and boats. Competitors shall have their own liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000 per event.
